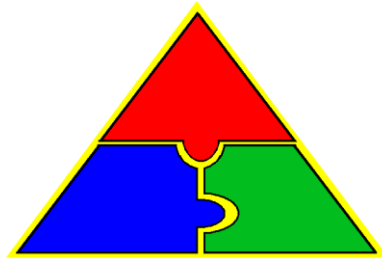

Christmas Jumper Day was a huge success today! All money donated will be given to Save the Children. We will let you know how much was raised on next week's newsletter.

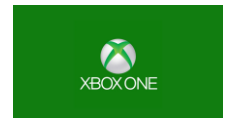

Safe Walking around school

Just a reminder regarding the green markings around school. These are the Safe Walking routes should the playground be icy. We hope we won't need them too often but as we are now into winter, green paths will be gritted first. Please ensure you follow the paths to avoid slippery surfaces.

Severe weather:

We are now into winter and the threat of severe weather is upon us. If we need to close the school due to severe weather we will send a text alert to parents and put the closure on the Wrexham Council website and our own school website. This could be at the start of the day or to close the school part way through the day. Please could you avoid phoning the school unless absolutely necessary in these circumstances.

When there has been overnight snowfall, we make the decision as early as possible as to whether school is open or closed. In the event of severe weather we may delay the start of the school day in order for us to prepare the school for opening. Our general principle is to open the school whenever possible - we use our knowledge of the school site, the weather forecast and our staff availability to do this. All of these help decide if we open, close or partly open.
