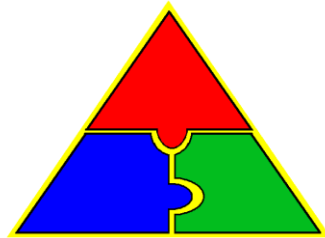

Governing Body meetings

The Governing Body has met regularly during the year and discussed a wide range of issues. No parent meetings were held during the last academic year with the Governing Body.

School Development/Improvement Plan and School Priorities.

The school has an annual school development/improvement plan, which identifies targets and focuses on what the school does well and what we need to do to improve. The targets are regularly discussed by staff and the Governing Body and monitored by the LA in termly meetings.

The school priorities for 2022/2023 were:

- To ensure the curriculum promotes well-being, equity and inclusion throughout the school with consistency.
- To develop assessment and progression in MYM in all 6 areas including well-being.
- To develop leadership at all levels.

School sports

Pupils have access to a good range of sports and outdoor, active activities, including football, rugby, dance and residential visits. Children participate in competitive and non-competitive sporting events throughout the year.

School attendance

At Ysgol Maes Y Mynydd, we celebrate good attendance and consistently monitor it. We have comprehensive procedures in place to address unauthorised absence such as regular contact between school and parents, and closely working with the Educational Social Worker.

The school's attendance for 2022/2023 for Year 1-6 was 90.80%.
