On applying for a Nursery and Reception place parents can state their preferred school but allocation of a place will be dependent on the number of places available at that school. A place in Nursery does not necessarily guarantee a place in Reception. The county council makes the decision as to which school your child will be offered a place in.

The same criteria apply for admission to secondary school for Year 6 pupils. If the school is oversubscribed, the local authority's over subscription criteria will be applied to allocate places.
